## WEATHER RELATED INFORMATION

### PLEASE READ:

- **Plow drivers cannot avoid plowing snow into driveways. To limit the amount, shovel your snow to the right of the driveway to prevent it from being plowed back into your driveway.**
- **Plowing snow onto roads after they have been cleared creates a driving hazard if it freezes.**
- **Stay back from plow trucks-snow blowing over the plow vehicle limits their vision.**
- **Bridges freeze before road surfaces.**
- **Refrain from driving during a snow emergency.**
- **Reduce speed when driving in snow.**
- **Do not park along roads, this is a Township ordinance.**
- **Keep trash cans safe from snow plows. The Township is not responsible for trash cans.**
- **Mailboxes should be installed as far back from the edge of the road as possible. Rolling snow is heavy and the Township cannot be responsible for mailboxes damaged due to snow.**
- **The Township does not plow state roads. (PENNDOT Maintenance Dept. - 610-798-4280)**
- **For EMERGENCIES call 911 and they will dispatch a snowplow immediately.**
